



# TREE REMOVAL NOTICE

Update on the Washington Boulevard and Paseo Padre Parkway Grade Separation Project

**In preparation for the upcoming Washington Boulevard / Paseo Padre Parkway Grade Separation Project, the trees within the City's property beyond your rear fence will be removed. This activity is scheduled for June 2005, pending weather or other unforeseen conditions.**

## **WHY ARE THE TREES BEING REMOVED?**

The trees are being removed to clear the property for upcoming demolition of eight vacant buildings that the City has acquired to provide space for the Washington Boulevard / Paseo Padre Parkway Grade Separation Project. After the buildings are removed some utility relocation work will begin.

## **WILL ANY TREES BE REMOVED FROM MY YARD?**

No trees within your yard will be removed. Only trees within the City's property will be removed, which may include trees with trunks immediately adjacent to your yard with foliage that may currently extend into your yard.

## **WILL THE WORK BE NOISY?**

Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum, although some noise from chainsaws and chippers will be unavoidable.

## **DURING WHAT HOURS WILL THE WORK BE PERFORMED?**

Tree removal will occur between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday.

## **HOW LONG WILL THE WORK TAKE?**

Tree removal is expected to take approximately one week to complete.



## **WHERE CAN I OBTAIN ADDITIONAL INFORMATION?**

A notice with more information about the upcoming demolition work and status of the Grade Separation project will be distributed in the next couple of weeks.
