Paseo Padre Parkway Grade Separation Project

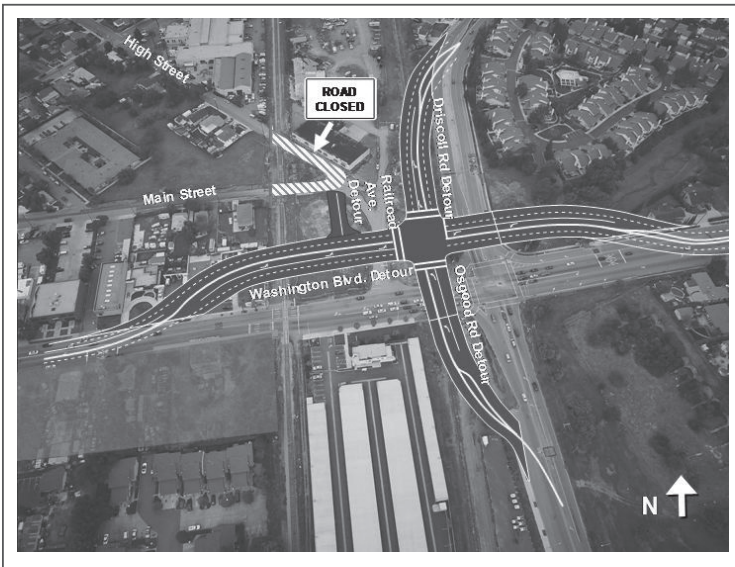

East End of Main and High Streets Will Be Closed Beginning the Week of November 19, 2007

The east end of Main and High Streets, west of the railroad tracks, will be closed beginning the week of November 19, 2007. This closure is necessary for the construction of the Washington Boulevard /Paseo Padre Parkway Grade Separation Project.

The traffic changes that will occur are as follows:

- Traffic will be prohibited east of the Union Pacific Railroad track on both Main and High Street until early to mid 2009. See picture below. The closure is necessary to relocate the existing railroad tracks as part of the Grade Separation project. Once the railroad tracks are relocated, this portion of Main and High Streets will be reopened and connected to the Railroad Avenue detour to provide a connection with the Washington Boulevard detour while it is in place. Traffic signs will be posted to alert motorists to these changes..



Note: Once construction of the Washington Boulevard overpass is complete, there will be no access from High and Main Streets to Washington Boulevard.
