



RAILROAD AVENUE CLOSURE NOTICE

Update on the Washington Boulevard/
Paseo Padre Parkway Grade Separation Project

JULY 2007

RAILROAD AVENUE WILL BE CLOSED IN THE NEAR FUTURE AND COULD BE AS EARLY AS JULY 9, 2007.

Railroad Avenue and access with Main/High Streets and Washington Boulevard will be closed in connection with the Washington Boulevard /Paseo Padre Parkway Grade Separation Project in the near future and could be as early as July 9, 2007.

The traffic changes that will occur are as follows:

- Railroad Avenue could be closed as early as July 9, 2007 through November 2007.
- Access between Main/High Streets and Washington Boulevard via Railroad Avenue will be permanently closed once Railroad Avenue is closed.
- In November 2007, Railroad Avenue will reopen and connect to the Washington Boulevard detour but access to Main and High Streets will remain closed as the existing Main and High Street railroad crossings will be closed.
- In early to mid 2009, after the existing Union Pacific Railroad track has been relocated, Main and High Streets will reopen to Railroad Avenue, but access to Washington Boulevard via Railroad Avenue will no longer be possible due to the final elevated configuration of Washington Boulevard which will be elevated 22 feet above Railroad Avenue.

Traffic signs will be posted to alert motorists to these changes.
