UNION PACIFIC REMOVAL OF RAILROAD BALLAST

In December 2008, Union Pacific Railroad (UP) completed removing the tracks from its former corridor, located in the Grade Separation Project area between Lake Elizabeth and Carol Road. UP's next removal operation along its former corridor is to remove the ballast (the rocks under the tracks).

Ballast removal is expected to start by Thursday, January 8, 2009 and continue for approximately two weeks pending weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING RAILROAD REMOVAL ACTIVITIES

All ballast removal activities will take place within the existing railroad right-of-way. However, trucks carrying the removed material will enter and exit the Washington Boulevard and Paseo Padre Parkway detour roadways to access the site. Union Pacific's contractor will assign flagmen to each location to make sure there is safe ingress and egress from the site. Water trucks will be on site to control the dust during this removal operation.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Union Pacific's contractor will comply with the City's construction working hours, which are 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays.
